


Care Instructions

SANITARY CERAMIC



Dear Customer!

We are pleased that you have chosen to buy a piece of sanitary ceramic from our range. To ensure that you can enjoy this item for many years to come, please observe the following care instructions.

DAILY CLEANING

Sanitary ceramic items are easy to care for and quick to clean. Household cleaning and care agents are suitable for the regular cleaning of bathroom ceramics. The smooth, dense and relatively scratch-resistant surfaces are resistant to all acids and alkalis commonly used in the household. The ceramic surfaces should be cleaned regularly with a soft, slightly damp and clean cloth. Abrasive cleaning agents can damage the surface.

STUBBORN STAINS

Sometimes it is possible that dirt cannot be easily removed with the described care. Here we recommend liquid or creamy bathroom cleaning agents. Household vinegar or diluted vinegar essence are tried and tested cleaning agents with which, for example, limescale deposits can be easily removed. For stubborn stains, you can also leave a household cloth soaked in vinegar water to soak overnight. Metallic traces of use (recognisable as black dots/lines), e.g. due to the abrasion of rings, belt buckles, etc., cannot be removed with mild detergents. The directly affected area can be treated with glass ceramic cleaner or a ceramic eraser. To protect the surface from possible damage, only use cleaning agents and utensils that do not have a scratching effect (such as a knife, spatula, brush, sanding or scouring agent, etc.) and are therefore suitable for cleaning.

TOILET CLEANING

When cleaning the toilet with special cleaning agents, you should always put the toilet lid and seat ring up during the entire cleaning process. This is the only way to ensure that the surfaces of your seat ring and lid are not exposed to the cleaning agent or its vapours.

GENERAL INFORMATION

You should be careful with all fluorine-containing substances that can be found in rust removers and toothpastes. Make sure that all residues are removed immediately, as stains can form if left on too long. Spray the cleaning agent on a soft cloth and not directly on the surfaces of the ceramic and dry all surfaces and rims thoroughly. This will prevent the cleaning agent from being applied to adjacent surfaces that may not be resistant to the ceramic cleaning agent used.
